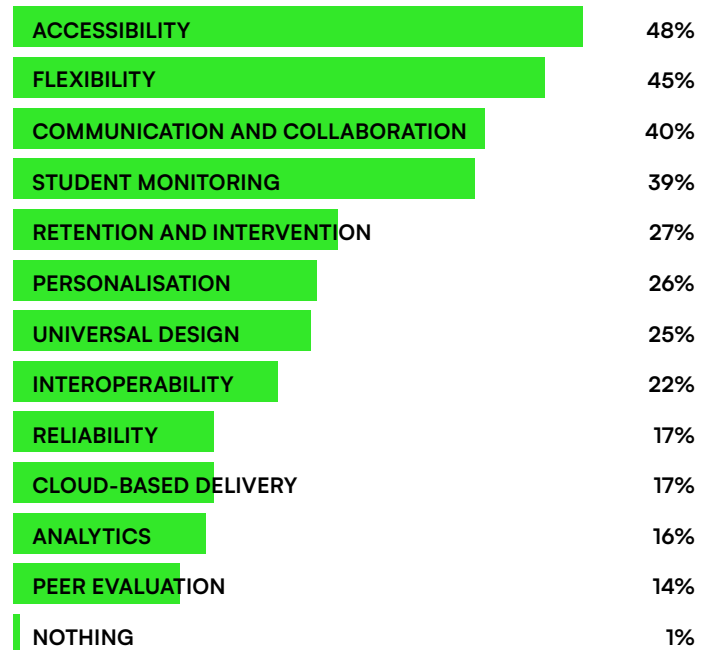

For 56 per cent of respondents, enhancing the student experience is the most important reason for pursuing digital transformation

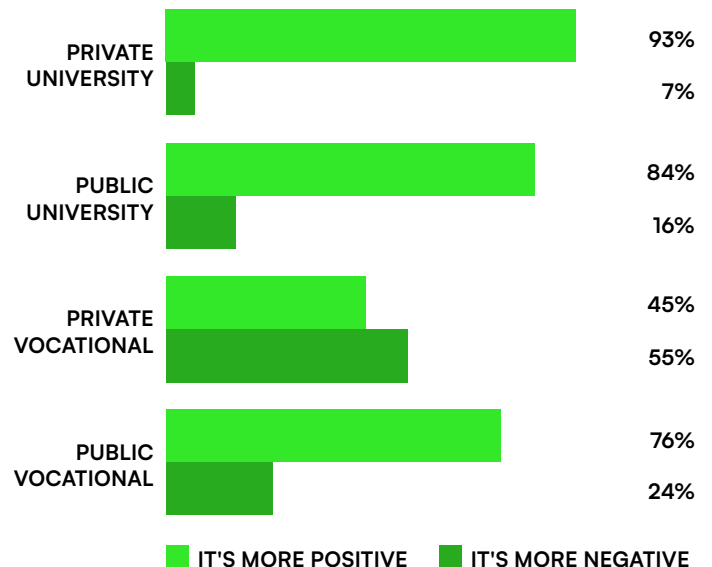

WHAT IS MOST IMPORTANT TO INSTITUTIONS IN A LEARNING MANAGEMENT SYSTEM?

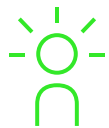


IF ATTITUDES TOWARDS EDTECH CHANGED BECAUSE OF THE PANDEMIC, HOW HAVE THEY CHANGED?
