GATE LEARNING TO STRUCTURE COURSE DELIVERY

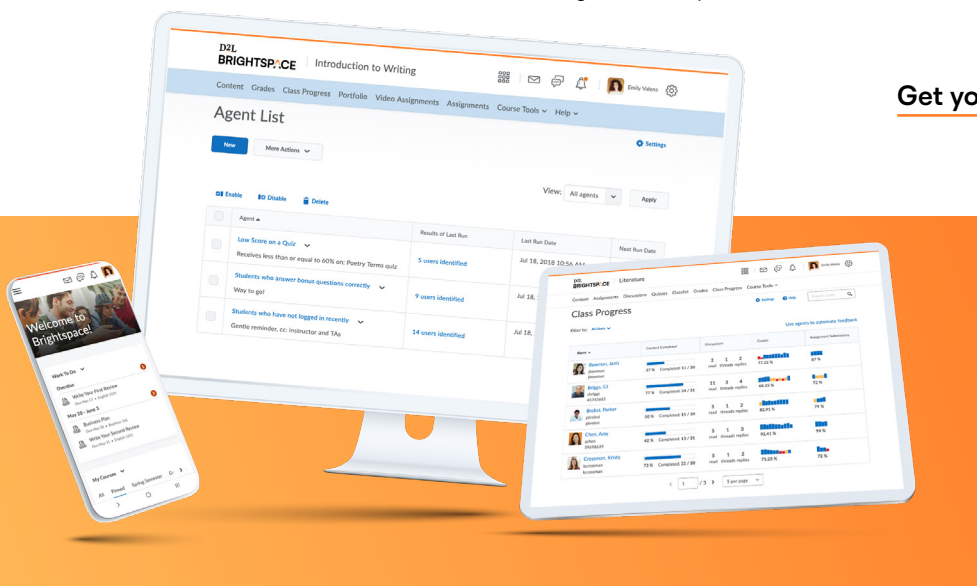
