



- MANAGEMENT
 - Create Categories, choose the calculation method and display options
 - Create Grade Items Items may be Numeric, Pass/Fail, Calculated, SelectBox, Text
- FUNCTIONALITY
 - Enter or change grades for individual items or several items at a time
 - Provide multimedia feedback for any item for learners and for teacher use only
