


The Brightspace Landing Page

When your child has logged into their district's Brightspace, they will come to the **Landing Page.**

While your district's page may look a bit different, there are some common elements to know:

- 1. Where to find your child's profile and setup notifications
- 2. Where to see new notifications
- 3. Where to access your child's courses

Click on the course you would like to access to move the **Course Homepage**.




What's on the Course Homepage?

Just like the Landing Page, each **Course Homepage** may look a bit different depending on how your child's teacher set up their classroom.

Some common elements to know:

- 4. Course Waffle to switch between classes

Submission folders are found here.


Students can track their assignments and see what has/has not been submitted, including due dates. Documentation tool to collect evidence of learning.

Can access Portfolios from previous years. Where you can find the lesson content that is being shared by the educator. Interactive tool for educators to share activities on the course homepage.

Social media-inspired communication tool.

- Portfolio makes it easy for your child to capture their learning and share with their teacher
- Teachers can provide feedback to students and their families to support the learning
- Portfolio can capture videos, photos, and documents
