


Get Started With These 7 Key Tools in D2L Brightspace on Day One

Encourage and facilitate active communication between students, teachers and parents to support better learning outcomes.




Announcements

Assessment


Assess any type of activity, including electronic, paper and observational assessments in the class, and provide efficient, rich and meaningful feedback.
